**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2012**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the
2 rest of the line and insert “and prescribing an effective date.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall develop a plan**
5 **for a Medicaid Buy-In program or a public option to provide an af-**
6 **fordable health care option to the six percent of Oregon residents who**
7 **do not have access to health care. The plan must:**

8 **“(a) Have no net cost to the state;**

9 **“(b) Provide a comprehensive package of benefits that are, at a**
10 **minimum, equivalent to the benefits offered by qualified plans offered**
11 **through the health insurance exchange;**

12 **“(c) Impose no more than minimal cost sharing, deductibles or**
13 **copayments;**

14 **“(d) Take into account the impact on the distribution of risk in the**
15 **health insurance market;**

16 **“(e) Encourage the utilization of premium tax credits available un-**
17 **der section 36B of the Internal Revenue Code and other subsidies**
18 **available under federal law;**

19 **“(f) Maximize the receipt of federal funds to support the costs of**
20 **the program or option;**

21 **“(g) Utilize the coordinated care organization health care delivery**

1 **model; and**

2 **“(h) Utilize the coordinated care organization provider networks to**
3 **the extent possible without destabilizing the networks.**

4 **“(2) No later than May 1, 2020, the authority shall report to the**
5 **Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the plan**
6 **developed in accordance with subsection (1) of this section including**
7 **recommendations for legislative changes necessary to implement the**
8 **plan and any federal approval that will be required to implement the**
9 **plan, such as demonstration projects under section 1115 of the Social**
10 **Security Act, a state plan amendment or a waiver for state innovation**
11 **under 42 U.S.C. 18052.**

12 **“SECTION 2. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
13 **date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative**
14 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
