PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2020

1 On page 23 of the printed bill, after line 6, insert:

2 "SECTION 31a. Procurement preferences. (1) As used in this sec3 tion:

"(a) 'Building materials' means asphalt, cement, concrete or any
other aggregate product, aluminum, steel, iron, coatings for steel and
iron, glass, manufactured wood products and copper.

"(b) 'Contracting agency' has the meaning given that term in ORS
279A.010.

9 "(2) Notwithstanding provisions of law requiring a contracting 10 agency to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder or best 11 proposer or provider of a quotation, and except as prohibited by federal 12 law, a contracting agency, when using funds from the Climate In-13 vestments Fund, shall give a preference of not more than 10 percent 14 to building materials procured from manufacturers within this state.

15 "(3) If the contracting agency finds in a written determination that 16 the building material is not available in the quantity, quality, type or 17 timeframe required for the procurement, or if the building material 18 cost is more than 10 percent more than the building material costs 19 manufactured within this state, the contracting agency may decline 20 to give the building material preference.".

After line 43, insert:

1 "SECTION 33a. Procurement preferences. (1) As used in this sec-2 tion:

"(a) 'Building materials' means asphalt, cement, concrete or any
other aggregate product, aluminum, steel, iron, coatings for steel and
iron, glass, manufactured wood products and copper.

6 "(b) 'Contracting agency' has the meaning given that term in ORS
7 279A.010.

8 "(c) 'Nursery stock' has the meaning given that term in ORS
9 571.005.

"(2) Notwithstanding provisions of law requiring a contracting agency to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder or best proposer or provider of a quotation, and except as prohibited by federal law, a contracting agency, when using funds from the Transportation Decarbonization Investments Account, shall give a preference of not more than 10 percent to:

"(a) Building materials procured from manufacturers within this
 state; and

"(b) Nursery stock that is grown, propagated and sold entirely
 within this state.

"(3) If the contracting agency finds in a written determination that the building material is not available in the quantity, quality, type or timeframe required for the procurement, or if the cost of the building material is more than 10 percent more than the building material costs manufactured within this state, the contracting agency may decline to give the building material preference.

"(4) If the contracting agency finds in a written determination that the nursery stock is not available in the quantity, quality, type or timeframe required for the procurement, or if the cost of the nursery stock is more than 10 percent more than the cost of nursery stock that is not grown, propagated and sold entirely within this state, the con1 tracting agency may decline to give the nursery stock preference.

"(5) This section does not apply to emergency work, minor alterations, ordinary repairs or maintenance work for public improvements
or to other construction contracts described in ORS 279C.320 (1).".
