PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2395

- On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 12 and 13 and insert:
- "(b) 'Consensus standard' means a standard that a standards development organization with national or industry-wide recognition promulgates.
- "(c) 'Manufacturer' means a person that manufactures, imports or contracts with another person to manufacture on the person's behalf a connected device that is sold or offered for sale in this state.".
- 8 In line 14, delete "(c)" and insert "(d)".
- 9 Delete lines 18 through 25 and insert:
- "(2) A manufacturer shall equip a connected device with reasonable security features. A reasonable security feature may consist of:
- "(a) A means for authentication from outside a local area network, including:
- "(A) A preprogrammed password that is unique for each connected device;
 or
- 16 "(B) A requirement that a user generate a new means of authentication 17 before gaining access to the connected device for the first time;
- "(b) Equipping a connected device with means to protect from unauthorized access, destruction, use, modification or disclosure that are consistent with a consensus standard, if the consensus standard addresses commonly known or reasonably foreseeable vulnerabilities in the connected device as

of the date on which the person manufactured the connected device; or

2 "(c) Compliance with requirements of federal law or federal regulations

3 that apply to security measures for connected devices.".
