6 "(2) If the Department of Transportation receives an application for 7 vehicle registration from a car rental company that was submitted to 8 an integrator and the application does not include the primary own-9 ership record for the motor vehicle, the department may issue regis-10 tration plates for the vehicle if the conditions described in subsection 11 (3) of this section are met.

"(3) Before the department may issue registration plates under
 subsection (2) of this section, a car rental company must:

"(a) Possess a valid Oregon vehicle dealer certificate issued or re newed under ORS 822.020 or 822.040;

"(b) Certify that the car rental company has not received the pri mary ownership record for the vehicle as of the date the application
 is submitted; and

"(c) Meet any other requirements adopted by the department byrule.

21 "(4) In addition to any fee for registration or issuance of registra-

tion plates, the department may charge a fee for providing the services
authorized by this section. The department shall establish the amount
of the fee by rule.

"(5) The department shall adopt rules to carry out the provisions
of this section.".
