PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2294

1 Delete lines 4 through 10 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part
of the wildlife laws.

4 **"SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

5 "(a) 'Chronic wasting disease' means a type of spongiform 6 encephalopathy that is transmissible among cervids and typified by 7 chronic and fatal weight loss.

8 "(b) 'Commercial cervid attractant' means a marketed product that 9 contains or is derived from cervid urine and is designed for use in 10 luring, attracting or enticing a cervid.

11 "(2) The Legislative Assembly finds and declares that:

"(a) Commercial cervid attractants sometimes contain the source
of chronic wasting disease;

14 "(b) There is no reliable test for determining the presence or ab-15 sence of chronic wasting disease in commercial cervid attractants; and 16 "(c) Banning the possession and use of commercial cervid 17 attractants will reduce the threat to the cervid population of this state 18 from chronic wasting disease.

"(3) A person may not possess or use commercial cervid
attractants.".
