PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2086

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 28 through 45.

2 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 13 and insert:

3 **"SECTION 3.** ORS 541.982 is amended to read:

"541.982. (1) An owner of working land may enter into a working land 4 conservation covenant with or grant a working land conservation easement $\mathbf{5}$ to an organization that is a holder, as defined in ORS 271.715, other than a 6 state agency. The covenant or easement must be for the *[purpose of ensuring*] 7 the continued use of **purposes of preserving and protecting** the land for 8 agricultural purposes [while] and maintaining or enhancing fish or wildlife 9 habitat, improving water quality or supporting other natural resource values 10 on the land. Except as provided under subsection (6) of this section, a 11 12 working land conservation covenant must be for a term of years that is established as permissible in [Oregon Agricultural Heritage Commission] 13 Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board rules. 14

"(2) In addition to the purposes required under subsection (1) of this section, a working land conservation covenant or working land conservation easement may provide for carrying out any purposes of a conservation easement, as defined in ORS 271.715. The covenant or easement must provide for carrying out those additional purposes in a manner consistent with ORS 271.715 to 271.795.

²¹ "(3) A working land conservation covenant or working land conservation

1 easement must:

"(a) Provide for regular monitoring by the organization [accepting] entering into the covenant or accepting the easement to ensure that the owner of the working land is adhering to the covenant or easement provisions; and

6 "(b) If identical in [*duration*] **term** to a conservation management plan 7 for the working land, refer to the conservation management plan in the text 8 of the covenant or easement.

9 "(4) An organization that enters into[,] or proposes to enter into[,] a 10 working land conservation covenant, or [accept] that accepts a working 11 land conservation easement, may apply to the [Oregon Watershed Enhance-12 ment] board for a grant to fund the purchasing, implementing[, carrying 13 out] or monitoring of the covenant or easement.

"(5) An application under subsection (4) of this section may be combined
 with an application under ORS 541.981 for a grant to fund the development,
 implementation or monitoring of a conservation management plan asso ciated with the working land conservation covenant or working land con servation easement.

"(6) The board shall adopt rules establishing three or more permis-19 sible terms of years for working land conservation covenants formed 20under this section. A permissible term for a covenant must be not less 21than 20 years or more than 50 years. However, notwithstanding the 22term of years established for a working land conservation covenant, 23an owner of working land may terminate the covenant at any time by 24giving not less than one year's notice to the organization that agreed 25to the covenant. 26

"(7) Notwithstanding ORS 271.725 or the term of years established
for a working land conservation easement, an owner of working land
may terminate a working land conservation easement at any time by:
"(a) Giving not less than one year's notice to the organization that

1 accepted the easement; and

"(b) Repaying the amount that the owner of working land received
as cash contributions, other financial assistance, in-kind services, investments, rental or easement payments, tax benefits or other benefits
in return for practices related to the easement.".

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
