**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2999**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert “creating new
2 provisions; and” and delete “811.605” and insert “811.602”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 16 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 811.602, as amended by section 3, chapter 69, Oregon
5 Laws 2018, is amended to read:

6 “811.602. (1) A disabled person parking permit is a means of identifying
7 vehicles being used to exercise the parking privileges described in ORS
8 811.635. The following are disabled person parking permits:

9 “(a) A special decal described in ORS 811.605 issued by the Department
10 of Transportation to be affixed to a golf cart or substantially similar vehicle;

11 “(b) An individual placard described in ORS 811.605;

12 “(c) A program placard issued by the department under ORS 811.607;

13 “(d) A family placard issued by the department under ORS 811.609;

14 “(e) A foreign visitor placard issued by the department under ORS 811.611;

15 “(f) A ‘Wheelchair User’ placard or decal issued by the department under
16 ORS 811.613; and

17 “(g) An ‘Oregon Wounded Warrior’ placard or decal issued by the de-
18 partment under section 2, chapter 69, Oregon Laws 2018.

19 “(2) The department shall issue a disabled person parking permit in the
20 form of a decal or individual placard to any person who submits an appli-
21 cation that complies with ORS 811.604. Nothing in this section prohibits the

1 department from issuing a decal or individual placard to a person who has
2 disabled veteran registration plates issued under ORS 805.100 and who qual-
3 ifies for the decal or placard.

4 “(3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the department may
5 not issue more than one individual placard to an applicant. The department
6 may issue a replacement placard upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the
7 department that the original placard has been lost, mutilated or destroyed.
8 The department may issue a temporary duplicate permit to a person who
9 needs a duplicate permit for travel purposes. A temporary duplicate permit
10 shall be valid for 30 days. The department shall adopt rules governing ap-
11 plication for and issuance of temporary duplicate permits. Nothing in this
12 subsection prohibits issuance of an individual placard to a person who has
13 been issued a decal.

14 “(4) Permits issued under this section[, *other than temporary duplicate*
15 *permits,*] may be renewed by mail.

16 “(5) Permits for use on vehicles that are regularly used as part of a pro-
17 gram for the transportation of persons with disabilities are issued as pro-
18 vided in ORS 811.607.

19 “(6) Except as provided in subsection (7) of this section, the department
20 shall determine the form, size and content of any decal or placard issued
21 under this section and shall adopt rules governing their issuance, display and
22 use as necessary to carry out this section.

23 “(7)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, the de-
24 partment may not require a decal or placard issued under this section to an
25 individual or a family to contain any identifying information about the per-
26 son to whom the decal or placard is issued, including any of the following:

27 “(A) Name;

28 “(B) Address;

29 “(C) Telephone number;

30 “(D) Social Security number;

- 1 “(E) Driver license number;
- 2 “(F) Golf cart driver permit number;
- 3 “(G) Identification card number;
- 4 “(H) Passport or visa number; or
- 5 “(I) Photograph.

6 “(b) The department may require a decal or placard issued under this
7 section to an individual or a family to contain not more than four digits of
8 the driver license or identification card number of the person to whom the
9 decal or placard is issued.

10 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 811.602, as amended by section 3, chapter 69, Oregon
11 Laws 2018, and section 1 of this 2019 Act, is amended to read:

12 “811.602. (1) A disabled person parking permit is a means of identifying
13 vehicles being used to exercise the parking privileges described in ORS
14 811.635. The following are disabled person parking permits:

15 “(a) A special decal described in ORS 811.605 issued by the Department
16 of Transportation to be affixed to a golf cart or substantially similar vehicle;

17 “(b) An individual placard described in ORS 811.605;

18 “(c) A program placard issued by the department under ORS 811.607;

19 “(d) A family placard issued by the department under ORS 811.609;

20 “(e) A foreign visitor placard issued by the department under ORS 811.611;

21 “(f) A ‘Wheelchair User’ placard or decal issued by the department under
22 ORS 811.613; and

23 “(g) An ‘Oregon Wounded Warrior’ placard or decal issued by the de-
24 partment under section 2, chapter 69, Oregon Laws 2018.

25 “(2) The department shall issue a disabled person parking permit in the
26 form of a decal or individual placard to any person who submits an appli-
27 cation that complies with ORS 811.604. Nothing in this section prohibits the
28 department from issuing a decal or individual placard to a person who has
29 disabled veteran registration plates issued under ORS 805.100 and who qual-
30 ifies for the decal or placard.

1 “(3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the department may
2 not issue more than one individual placard to an applicant. The department
3 may issue a replacement placard upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the
4 department that the original placard has been lost, mutilated or destroyed.
5 The department may issue a temporary duplicate permit to a person who
6 needs a duplicate permit for travel purposes. A temporary duplicate permit
7 shall be valid for [30] **120** days. The department shall adopt rules governing
8 application for and issuance of temporary duplicate permits. Nothing in this
9 subsection prohibits issuance of an individual placard to a person who has
10 been issued a decal.

11 “(4) Permits issued under this section may be renewed by mail.

12 “(5) Permits for use on vehicles that are regularly used as part of a pro-
13 gram for the transportation of persons with disabilities are issued as pro-
14 vided in ORS 811.607.

15 “(6) Except as provided in subsection (7) of this section, the department
16 shall determine the form, size and content of any decal or placard issued
17 under this section and shall adopt rules governing their issuance, display and
18 use as necessary to carry out this section.

19 “(7)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, the de-
20 partment may not require a decal or placard issued under this section to an
21 individual or a family to contain any identifying information about the per-
22 son to whom the decal or placard is issued, including any of the following:

23 “(A) Name;

24 “(B) Address;

25 “(C) Telephone number;

26 “(D) Social Security number;

29 “(G) Identification card number;

30 “(H) Passport or visa number; or

1 “(I) Photograph.

2 “(b) The department may require a decal or placard issued under this
3 section to an individual or a family to contain not more than four digits of
4 the driver license or identification card number of the person to whom the
5 decal or placard is issued.

6 “**SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 811.602 by section 2 of this**
7 **2019 Act become operative on July 6, 2020.”.**

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
