**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 431**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 3, delete “and 198.510” and
2 insert “, 198.510 and 255.012”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 8 through 12 and insert:

4 “(b) Protects or restores natural landscapes;

5 “(c) Uses rain gardens, porous pavements, green roofs, infiltration
6 planters, trees, tree boxes, bioswales or other green infrastructure strategies;
7 or

8 “(d) Harvests rain water from an artificial impervious surface for
9 nonpotable uses, including landscape irrigation and toilet flushing.”.

10 On page 4, delete lines 4 through 9 and insert:

11 “(m) One director who resides in a neighborhood within the boundaries
12 of Multnomah County Drainage District No. 1, Peninsula Drainage District
13 No. 1, Peninsula Drainage District No. 2 or Sandy Drainage Improvement
14 Company appointed by the Governor.

15 “(n) One director who represents a private sector business located within
16 the boundaries of Multnomah County Drainage District No. 1, Peninsula
17 Drainage District No. 1, Peninsula Drainage District No. 2 or Sandy Drain-
18 age Improvement Company appointed by the Governor.

19 “(o) Three directors who represent public interest nonprofit corporations
20 with expertise or interest related to the territory within the boundaries of
21 Multnomah County Drainage District No. 1, Peninsula Drainage District No.

1 1, Peninsula Drainage District No. 2 or Sandy Drainage Improvement Com-
2 pany appointed by the Governor, of which.”.

3 On page 8, line 7, delete “(a)”.

4 Delete lines 9 through 12.

5 Delete lines 20 through 24 and insert:

6 “(b) Across or along any stream of water or watercourse, any ground
7 water resource or any affected lands that are the property of the state or of
8 any political subdivision of the state.

9 “(2) When constructing works under this section, the district shall comply
10 with all federal, state and local permitting and regulatory requirements and
11 restrictions applicable to the district’s work in a street, right of way, stream
12 of water or watercourse or ground water resource that is the property of the
13 state or of any political subdivision of the state.”.

14 On page 9, delete lines 10 through 14 and insert:

15 **“SECTION 18. Ad valorem property taxes; collection; enforcement.**

16 (1)(a) The urban flood safety and water quality district may annually impose,
17 assess and collect a tax on all taxable property located in the district in an
18 amount sufficient to pay the principal and interest due in the fiscal year on
19 outstanding general obligation bonds issued by the district.”.

20 In line 22, delete “constructing,” and insert “acquiring, purchasing, con-
21 structing, improving,”.

22 In line 29, after the first “of” insert “acquiring, purchasing, constructing,
23 improving,”.

24 Delete line 45.

25 On page 10, delete lines 1 through 3 and insert:

26 **“SECTION 20. General obligation bonds; refunding bonds; proce-**

27 **dures.** (1)(a) Upon approval of the electors of the urban flood safety and
28 water quality district, the district may issue general obligation bonds. The
29 district may not issue or have outstanding at the time of issuance general
30 obligation bonds in a principal amount that exceeds two percent of the real

1 market value of all taxable property in the district, calculated as provided
2 under ORS 308.207.”.

3 Delete lines 11 through 30.

4 In line 31, delete “(7)” and insert “(2)”.

5 On page 15, after line 33, insert:

6 **“SECTION 31.** ORS 255.012 is amended to read:

7 “255.012. As used in this chapter, ‘district’ means:

8 “(1) A domestic water supply district organized under ORS chapter 264.

9 “(2) A cemetery maintenance district organized under ORS chapter 265.

10 “(3) A park and recreation district organized under ORS chapter 266.

11 “(4) A mass transit district organized under ORS 267.010 to 267.390.

12 “(5) A transportation district organized under ORS 267.510 to 267.650.

13 “(6) A metropolitan service district organized under ORS chapter 268.

14 “(7) A translator district organized under ORS 354.605 to 354.715.

15 “(8) A library district organized under ORS 357.216 to 357.286.

16 “(9) A county road district organized under ORS 371.055 to 371.110.

17 “(10) A special road district organized under ORS 371.305 to 371.360.

18 “(11) A road assessment district organized under ORS 371.405 to 371.535.

19 “(12) A highway lighting district organized under ORS chapter 372.

20 “(13) A health district organized under ORS 440.305 to 440.410.

21 “(14) A sanitary district organized under ORS 450.005 to 450.245.

22 “(15) A sanitary authority, water authority or joint water and sanitary
23 authority organized under ORS 450.600 to 450.989.

24 “(16) A county service district organized under ORS chapter 451.

25 “(17) A vector control district organized under ORS 452.020 to 452.170.

26 “(18) A rural fire protection district organized under ORS chapter 478.

27 “(19) An airport district organized under ORS chapter 838.

28 “(20) A geothermal heating district organized under ORS chapter 523.

29 “(21) A water improvement district organized under ORS chapter 552.

30 “(22) A water control district organized under ORS chapter 553.

1 “(23) A weather modification district organized under ORS 558.200 to
2 558.440.

3 “(24) A livestock district organized under ORS 607.005 to 607.051.

4 “(25) A port organized under ORS 777.005 to 777.725 and 777.915 to 777.953.

5 “(26) The Port of Portland established by ORS 778.010.

6 “(27) A school district.

7 “(28) Territory, other than territory within a city, proposed to be created,
8 formed or incorporated into a district or to be annexed or otherwise added
9 to a district.

10 “(29) A soil and water conservation district organized under ORS 568.210
11 to 568.810 and 568.900 to 568.933.

12 “(30) A heritage district organized under ORS 358.442 to 358.474.

13 “(31) A radio and data district organized under ORS 403.500 to 403.542.

14 “(32) A sand control district organized under ORS 555.500 to 555.535.

15 **“(33) An urban flood safety and water quality district created under**
16 **sections 1 to 26 of this 2019 Act.”.**

17 In line 37, delete “31” and insert “32”.

18 In line 43, delete “32” and insert “33”.

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
