"(9) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-18 tation on expenditures established by section 1 (1), chapter 185, Oregon 19 Laws 2019 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5534), for the biennium beginning July 201, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, 21moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-22cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the 23Public Utility Commission, for the utility program, is increased by 24\$2,132,573. 25
