PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2206

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete the first semicolon 2 and insert a period and delete the rest of the line.

3 Delete lines 6 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

"(2) The State Resilience Officer shall study standards and procedures for
determining whether buildings may be safely occupied after an emergency.
Standards must align with national standards.

"(3) In conducting the study described in subsection (2) of this section,
8 the State Resilience Officer shall consult with:

9 "(a) Local governments;

"(b) Relevant state agencies or offices, including the State Fire Marshal;and

"(c) Relevant professional organizations, including organizations repre senting architects, engineers and building safety professionals.

"SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Office of the Governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$300,000 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this 2019 Act.".
