

**PROPOSED CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 688**

1 In line 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after “authorizations” insert “;  
2 creating new provisions; and amending section 1, chapter 142, Oregon Laws  
3 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3030)”.

4 Delete lines 5 through 10 and insert:

5 “(a) ‘Professional licensing board’ has the meaning given that term in  
6 section 1, chapter 142, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 3030).

7 “(b) ‘Temporary authorization’ means an authorization issued under sec-  
8 tion 1, chapter 142, Oregon Laws 2019 (House Bill 3030).”.

9 After line 24, insert:

10 **“SECTION 2.** Section 1, chapter 142, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House  
11 Bill 3030), is amended to read:

12 **“Sec. 1.** (1) As used in this section:

13 “(a) ‘Occupational or professional service’ means a service:

14 “(A) For which an individual must possess a license, certificate or other  
15 form of authorization to provide under the laws of this state; and

16 “(B) Over which a professional licensing board has regulatory oversight.

17 “(b) ‘Professional licensing board’ means a state agency or board that li-  
18 censes, certifies or otherwise authorizes individuals to provide an occupa-  
19 tional or professional service.

20 “(2) A professional licensing board [*may*] **shall** issue a temporary au-  
21 thorization to provide the occupational or professional service regulated by  
22 the professional licensing board to a person who:

1       “(a) Is the spouse of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States  
2 who is stationed in this state;

3       “(b) Holds a current authorization to provide the occupational or profes-  
4 sional service issued by another state and the professional licensing board  
5 determines that the other state’s authorization requirements are substan-  
6 tially similar to those of the professional licensing board;

7       “(c) Provides to the professional licensing board, in a manner determined  
8 by the professional licensing board, sufficient proof that the person is in  
9 good standing with the issuing out-of-state professional licensing board; and

10       “(d) Has demonstrated competency, as determined by the professional li-  
11 censing board by rule, over the occupational or professional service regu-  
12 lated by the professional licensing board.

13       “(3)(a) A temporary authorization issued under this section is valid until  
14 the earliest of the following:

15       “(A) Two years after the date of issuance;

16       “(B) The date the spouse of the person to whom the authorization was  
17 issued completes the spouse’s term of service in this state; or

18       “(C) The date the person’s authorization issued by another state expires.

19       “(b) An authorization issued under this section is not renewable. A person  
20 may not continue to provide the occupational or professional service unless  
21 the person is issued a full authorization under the laws of this state to pro-  
22 vide the occupational or professional service.

23       “(4) A professional licensing board may adopt rules to carry out the pro-  
24 visions of this section.”.

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
