Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 4057
Prohibits Oregon State Lottery from offering games based on outcomes of sporting events organized by, sponsored by or played in connection with post-secondary institutions of education.
- HB 4153
Prohibits Oregon State Lottery from offering games playable via mobile phone, personal computer or other personal electronic device, except for live sports betting and certain multistate numbers drawing games.
- HB 4007
Provides that individual otherwise eligible for unemployment insurance benefits is not disqualified for any week that individual's unemployment is due to labor dispute in active progress at individual's place of employment.

Work Session

- HB 4008
Permits insurer to exclude from coverage under motor vehicle liability insurance policy person other than named insured based on certain specified criteria.
- HB 4058
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/10/2020 AGENDA: Specifies conditions for requiring, issuing and maintaining in effect surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit for person that creates, attaches, asserts or claims lien in connection with making, altering, repairing, transporting, storing, performing services, supplying materials or performing labor in connection with motor vehicle.
- HB 4087 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/10/2020 AGENDA: Directs portion of remainder of moneys collected from employers as civil penalties for violations of certain employment laws to be credited to Bureau of Labor and Industries Account to provide technical assistance to employers. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

- HB 4108
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/10/2020 AGENDA: Provides that for purposes of determining salary of certain member of Public Employees Retirement System, housing allowance paid to prison chaplain shall be treated as includable in member's taxable income under Oregon law.
- HB 4113
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/10/2020 AGENDA: Authorizes Bureau of Labor and Industries to conduct inquiries and investigations, including criminal records checks, to determine whether employer and any employees of employer have adequate character and fitness to employ minors in compliance with provisions relating to employment of minors.
- HB 4125
Requires insurer to mail or deliver notice of cancellation of automobile insurance policy at least 30 days before effective date of cancellation.
- HB 4143
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/10/2020 AGENDA: Prohibits spending moneys of State of Oregon or of public body on or for benefit of industry-recognized apprenticeship programs.
