Public Hearing

- HB 4044 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Makes permanent small school district grants and school district funding for foreign exchange students.
- HB 4136
Removes requirement that grants for certain student transportation costs be prioritized for school districts that did not receive public moneys in previous school year for same student transportation costs.
- HB 4137
Authorizes all public universities in Oregon to offer doctoral degrees, subject to approval by Higher Education Coordinating Commission.
- HB 4099 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Provides that student who legally entered United States under Compact of Free Association treaty between United States and Republic of Palau, Republic of the Marshall Islands or Federated States of Micronesia and who has not previously established residence in any state or territory of United States other than Oregon qualifies for exemption from nonresident tuition and fees at public universities and is eligible to receive state and university scholarships or other financial aid.

Work Session

- HB 4055 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study and develop recommendations on how Oregon's community colleges and public universities can best combat food and housing insecurity among their students.
- HB 4056
Approves Proposed and Final Order of Higher Education Coordinating Commission dated December 12, 2019, transferring northernmost portion of Lake County from Central Oregon Community College Service District to Klamath Community College Service District.
- HB 4127
Directs school districts to provide age-appropriate instruction in oral health as part of health education curriculum.

- HB 4128 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires each public post-secondary institution of education to develop and use assessment system to determine student eligibility to enroll in lower-division collegiate coursework in English or mathematics.
- HB 4132 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Oregon Health Authority to administer and collect data from student health surveys.
- HB 4146 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Provides that part-time faculty member at public institution of higher education who qualifies for health care benefits will pay 10 percent of insurance premiums for employee coverage.
