HB 4098 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Education to develop statewide, long-term strategic plan to provide computer science education. HB 4139

Prescribes notification requirements for school district upon receipt of report of act of harassment, intimidation, bullying or cyberbullying.

HB 4044 \*\*

Makes permanent small school district grants and school district funding for foreign exchange students. HB 4099 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides that student who legally entered United States under Compact of Free Association treaty between United States and Republic of Palau, Republic of the Marshall Islands or Federated States of Micronesia and who has not previously established residence in any state or territory of United States other than Oregon qualifies for exemption from nonresident tuition and fees at public universities and is eligible to receive state and university scholarships or other financial aid.

HB 4136

Removes requirement that grants for certain student transportation costs be prioritized for school districts that did not receive public moneys in previous school year for same student transportation costs.

HB 4137

Authorizes all public universities in Oregon to offer doctoral degrees, subject to approval by Higher Education Coordinating Commission.
