HB 4151 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases rate of privilege tax imposed on Oregon motor vehicle dealers upon retail sale of taxable motor vehicle and rate of use tax imposed on storage, use or other consumption in this state of taxable motor vehicle purchased at retail.

Please note: HB 4159 is scheduled solely for the purpose of moving to the House Committee on Rules.

Work Session

HB 4159 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Modifies statewide greenhouse gas emissions reduction goals.

HB 4024

Prohibits certain products that use or contain hydrofluorocarbons from entering into commerce in Oregon if product was manufactured after specified date.

Possible Work Session

HB 4049

Establishes eligibility for renewable energy certificates for facilities that generate electricity from direct combustion of municipal solid waste and became operational before January 1, 1995, if such facilities register with Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System at any time.

HB 4093

Exempts wood residue combusted as fuel or that has marketable value from solid waste regulation.
