CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-11-2020 MEETING: Makes routine staying of Water Resources Commission or Water Resources Department final order upon filing of petition for judicial review inapplicable if order enforces terms and conditions of use of water or priority of use of water.
- HB 4069
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-11-2020 MEETING: Authorizes Water Resources Department to require reporting of water use measurements.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-11-2020 MEETING: Directs Department of Environmental Quality to purchase cyanotoxin autoanalyzer system and associated supplies and services.
- HB 4077
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-11-2020 MEETING: Requires seller of real property to test well water used for domestic purposes.
- HB 4043
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-11-2020 MEETING: Prohibits local government, local contracting agency or local contract review board from enacting, adopting or enforcing ordinance, resolution, rule or other law that prohibits, restricts or limits evaluation, comparison or use of pipe or piping materials for water project if pipe or piping materials meet current standards or performance specifications of specified organizations and moneys appropriated from State Treasury directly or indirectly provided funding for water project.
