Public Hearing

- SB 1546
Specifies procedures for providing notice to defendant in charging instrument and at arraignment when conviction would result in firearm prohibition.
- SB 1547
Creates exception to requirement that court proceeding involving person in custody be transferred from court facility in Gresham to Portland if defendant is not in custody and certain warrants have been vacated or executed.
- SB 1568
Modifies protective proceedings to permit vulnerable youth guardianships for adults between 18 and 21 years of age who are not citizens or lawful permanent residents of United States and who are unable to be reunified with parent due to abuse, neglect or abandonment that occurred before adult attained 18 years of age.

Work Session

- SB 1503
Provides that person commits offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants if person has blood alcohol level of 0.08 percent or more by weight within two hours after driving vehicle.
