Upon passage, this bill will work to make school and workplace dress codes more equitable by mandating that they do "not have a disproportionate adverse impact on members of a protected class to a greater extent than the policy impacts persons generally."

We encourage your support of this bill as it will provide protection for Oregonians and how they express their themselves, regardless of their race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, marital status, age, or disability.
