Support HB4107 House Judiciary Committee February 3, 2020

Chair Sanchez, Vice Chairs Bynum and Sprenger and Members of the House Judiciary Committee:

On behalf of The Oregon Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force, we offer our support of HB4107 – the Non-Discrimination Act of 2020, with a particular focus on The CROWN Act.

The Oregon Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force is a private, non-profit, non-governmental statewide agency with over 100 multi-disciplinary members appointed by the Attorney General. Members serve as advisors on 1 of 8 subcommittees including: Advocacy Response, Campus, Criminal Justice, Legislative & Public Policy, Medical-Forensic, Men's Engagement, Offender Management, and Prevention Education.

Our mission is to advance a multi-disciplinary, survivor-centered approach to the prevention of and response to sexual violence in Oregon. Our goal is to prevent sexual violence from happening in the first place, while simultaneously improving our response efforts to mitigate trauma and ensure the safety and security of all victims.

The CROWN Act aligns with our mission to prevent sexual violence by reinforcing dignity and autonomy for all Oregonians. It reduces the risk of discrimination, harassment, abuse, and violence by establishing that dress codes in the workplace and educational settings are equitable and do "not have a disproportionate adverse impact on members of a protected class to a greater extent than the policy impacts persons generally."

HB4107 is a critical step toward the implementation of protective factors against discrimination. It is with great pleasure that we support this legislation and urge your support of its passage.
