With any gun lock down law, how would my 16-year-old son who has been through firearms training and hunter safety courses be able to grab one of our guns to help protect his 112lb mother who is being chased down by a pitbull up and into our own home If the gun is locked up? Is he supposed to get on the phone and call 911 and wait 20 to 30 minutes for someone to show up while watching his mother get chewed to pieces?
