Restoring the Oregon Caves Chateau

- In 2006, the National Park Service was giving serious consideration to permanently closing this physically declining National Historic Landmark lodge, the Oregon Caves Chateau.
- In 2007, the Friends of the Oregon Caves and Chateau was founded to rally support for the Lodge and it's restoration—one of the three GREAT Lodges in Oregon.
- Strong responses from Oregon foundations, individuals, businesses, the State of Oregon, Travel Oregon and the Oregon Congressional Delegation turned the tide.
- The **National Park Service** subsequently committed \$17 Million to infrastructure upgrade of the Chateau.
- And the **Friends of the Oregon Caves and Chateau** then committed





raising the balance of the \$21 Million needed to fully restore this unique **Oregon treasure**.

- The NPS bids have gone out, a contractor will be chosen in late January, with the goal of re-opening the fully restored lodge in 2021.
- Help raise and fund the \$1.4 million needed to complete the restoration of the Historic Interior and the iconic
 Monterey furniture collection and create a sustainable operations plan for the future.
