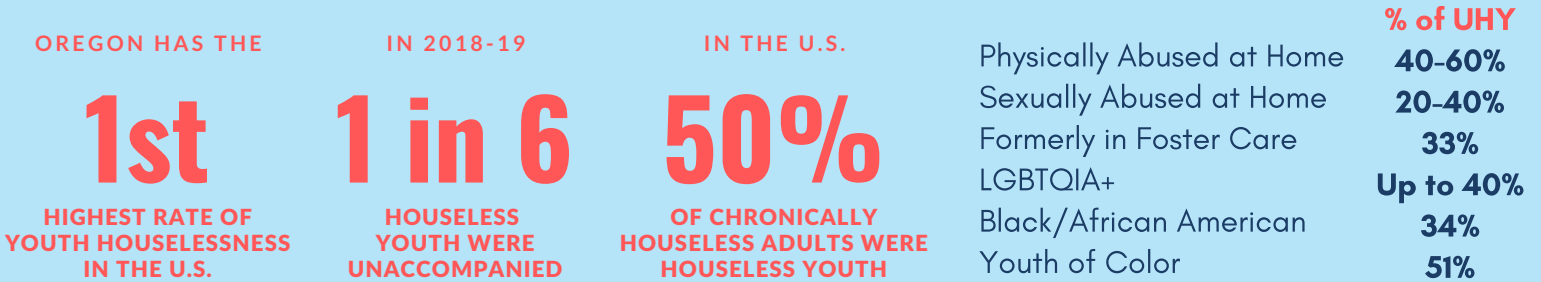


# Meeting the Needs of Oregon's Unaccompanied Houseless Youth (UHY)

HB 4039



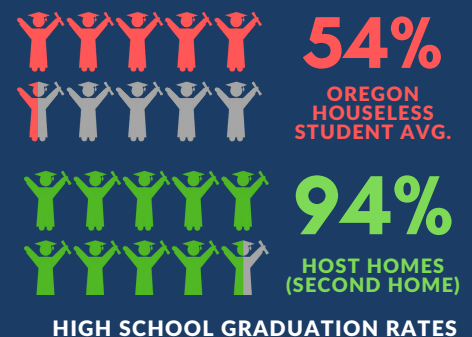
## CREATING A ROBUST CONTINUUM

\$300,000 for DHS and UHY programs to conduct assessment of needs and design an investment plan for a statewide continuum of services.

## RAPID INVESTMENT 1: EXPAND HOST HOME NETWORK

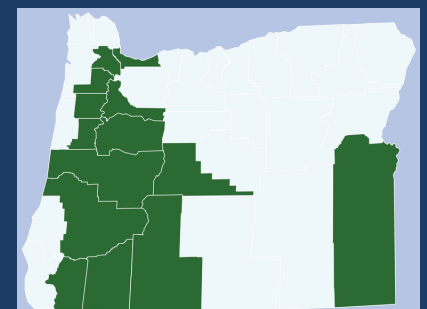
\$1.2m for host home housing that keeps youth in school.

- Up to 26,000 total nights of long-term housing.
- Expansion of short-term housing programs.



## RAPID INVESTMENT 2: EXPAND SHELTER & SUPPORT SERVICES

\$1m to expand or enhance existing UHY shelter facilities, outreach, culturally specific services, mental health/substance use services, other transitional housing options.

For every \$1 invested in UHY,  
Oregon saves \$4.

ACTIVITY (>25% OF UHY)**



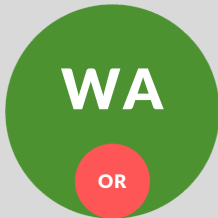
**HEAVY DRUG
