Dear Chair Lively and members of the Committee,

My name is Sunnie Day Sanchez and I am an OMMP Patient. In 2018, I had the opportunity to participate on an OHA RAC concerning rules introducing the Cannabis Tracking System to registered grow sites with 12 or more plants. In 2019, I also had the opportunity to participate on the OHA RAC and on an OLCC RAC concerning legislation passed in 2019.

I am writing to express my support for HB 4035. However, I oppose the -4 amendment that adds the Oregon Cannabis Commission, which has failed to fulfill the scope of their work concerning the future governance of the Oregon Medical Marijuana Program. This is an advisory commission not a regulatory commission. Additionally, the Oregon Cannabis Commission currently works closely with the Governor's Office in which their work will be represented.

I would like to suggest that the scope of the Oregon Cannabis Commission be modified to facilitate a viable plan for a "social equity".

I appreciate the opportunity to provide this brief testimony to the House Committee on Economic Development.

Please do not adopt the -4 amendment.
