

I submit this exhibit to request an amendment of HB 4065 to include new provisions and amendment of ORS 25.750 Suspension of licenses, certificates, permits and registrations for unpaid Child Support.

My name is Victor Reppeto. I am 53. I have been homeless for four years now. A friend lets me park a camper on his property. I lost my left leg when I was 13. I suffer from mental health issues due to abuse I suffered from the time I was three, through my childhood and most of my teen years. In spite of this and in spite of the years I spent fighting addiction I had a family, a career and built a small estate.

In 2013 I was still married to my ex-wife Elizabeth. After years of begging her to get help I finally made it known I was willing to consider divorce if she continued to refuse. She had withheld payment on our mortgage for several months without telling me. She had been allowing people to live in our rentals without paying rent and lied about it. She was fired after 18 years at Blue Cross for similar behavior. I had been a stay at home dad for 13 years with 3 children, two of which had highly demanding special needs. Knowing that she was going to lose any custody battle she went to the police and filed a false report for domestic violence. The ploy was successful. Judge Sally Avera ordered and renewed a restraining order against me for three years. The resume I submitted showing years of recovery and parenting classes and continuing education was disregarded. I was charged with assault constituting domestic violence. I was acquitted of everything but harassment. Even though this does not constitute domestic violence Judge Sally Avera had that entered into my criminal record anyway. She leveled \$600 per month child support against me even though Elizabeth had been the bread winner and I was an unemployed home maker. She sent me a message ordering me to leave the children to Elizabeth's care. She did not like my answer and retaliated by setting aside the equitable agreement we had made and gave most of the estate to Elizabeth. I have spent years since fighting false 'contempt of cop' charges because I refused to move away from the Salem area when ordered to do so by Judge Sally Avera. The message was delivered by Rep Mike Nearman. He also reprimanded me for filing complaints with the appropriate authorities. No one is willing to hold Elizabeth accountable. No one is willing to do anything to stop the punishment I continue to endure. After suffering what I assume to be a minor stroke in 2013 on top of the other physical and mental disabilities there is not enough left of me to rebuild my career and my estate. According to Oregon Law it is illegal for me to even use an electric bicycle to compensate for my disability.

Please consider an amendment to these draconian rules, I beg you.
