Honorable Members of the House,

HB 4005 is barking up the wrong tree in so many ways. It is, essentially, a gun control bill that, on the face, and deep down, violates the Second Amendment that is simply a recognition of the freedom of men and women to defend themselves against criminals and bad governments and to enjoy shooting and hunting.
