The Yamhill County Board of Commissioners voted unanimously on February 6, 2020 to OPPOSE HB 4005 in it's entirety.

The bill, if passed, would severely negatively impact youth shooting sports.

The Board has long recognized and supported youth shooting sports programs such as 4 H and Clay Target League programs.

This bill would penalize and criminalize current youth shooting program participants. Please give serious thought to what the ramifications of this bill would be.

Youth shooting programs should not be jeopardized and would be should this bill become law.
