

HB 4044 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Makes permanent school district grants and school district funding for foreign exchange students. Allows individuals who are foreign exchange students and residing in Oregon to be considered residents of the school district where the dormitory is located. Specifies for residency requirements what is required of individual applying for residency. Defines foreign exchange student. Requires Oregon Department of Education to transfer \$2.5 million each fiscal year from the State School Fund to the Small School District Supplemental Fund. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The provision that allowed children who were foreign exchange students and resided in dormitories operated by school districts to be considered residents of those school districts for funding purposes sunsets at the end of the biennium. Districts that host these students are allowed to receive funding for them, because the State School Fund distribution formula distributes the legislatively appropriated budget to school districts based on the number of students the district has as well as specific characteristics of those students.

House Bill 4044 would remove the sunset allowing districts to receive funding for foreign exchange students who reside in school district dormitories.
