I am a farmer in rural Marion county and am opposed to SB1530. This bill would impact our farm through higher costs for our farm inputs. We are unable to increase the price we charge for our products as we must compete with products from other States and Countries. This bill would have zero impact on global carbon reduction. It will increase fuel costs for Oregon families, hospitals, and industries. These costs increases will be passed on to every Oregonian through increases in goods and services. Why should every Oregonian pay for this when there will be no impact on global carbon reduction?
