Building a facility that transports dirty energy products is something all of us do not need. Building a structure and a transport system to bring in oil, coal or any other dirty energy products are prone to spills. Infrastructure buildings do not last long and usually have faults built into them which breaks at the most infrequent rate that damages the environment and destroys areas for centuries. We do not want to ever see any building of this type of structure ever.
