5 WHEREAS, the Coos County Board of Commissioners represents an estimated 64,000 people;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, the residents of Coos County have endured for many years of the impacts from
8 wildfire smoke, lack of timber harvest and the improper management of timber lands in and
around our county which has and continues to severely impact our economy; and

9 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1530 will directly increase the utility costs and fuel costs that will further
10 burden the residents of Coos County who are already burdened by the increasing cost of living
11 in our county through delivered goods and services which are dependent on truck
transportation; and

12 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1530 will directly increase the cost to Coos County and the residents of
13 Coos County by causing significant increases in fuel costs; and


14 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1530 will significantly hinder the ability of Coos County residents to
15 recover from years of economic decline caused by adverse public land policies; and

16 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1530 will not reduce the CO2 in the atmosphere.
