There are thousands of families all over this State using small timber farms as sources of income to fund long term care for aging parents. This new tax will make it far more expensive to cut and transport the timber, and mills due to increased energy costs will have to lower prices offered for those logs so our local lumber can stay competitive in a world market.

This new energy tax will reduce the income from those small tree farms many families so desperately need to help care for ageing elders.

As a logger, small businessman, and son of two parents who perished from dementia related illness I urge you to drop this extremely expensive and unneeded plan."
