Re: Legislative Review of Executive Appointments

LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Land Conservation and Development Commission subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Appointees

Statement of Economic Interest²

Required.

Statutory Requirements³

The commission consists of seven members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate.⁴ At least one member shall be or have been an elected city official in Oregon and at least one member shall be an elected county official at the time of appointment. Members serve four year terms and may be removed by the Governor for cause.

- One member must represent Clatsop, Columbia, Coos, Curry, Lincoln and Tillamook Counties and those portions of Douglas and Lane Counties lying west of the summit of the Coast Range (CRIBBINS);
- Two members must represent Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington Counties (HALLOVA, PEARMINE);
- One member must Benton, Linn, Marion, Polk and Yamhill Counties and that portion of Lane County lying east of the summit of the Coast Range (SANDOVAL);
- One member must represent Jackson and Josephine Counties and that portion of Douglas County lying east of the summit of the Coast Range (**WARREN**);

- One member must represent Baker, Crook, Deschutes, Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Hood River, Jefferson, Klamath, Lake, Malheur, Morrow, Sherman, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, Wasco and Wheeler Counties (MORROW); and
- One member must represent Benton, Clackamas, Linn, Marion, Multnomah, Polk, Washington and Yamhill Counties and that portion of Lane County lying east of the summit of the Coast Range (MCARTHUR).

Duties and Authority

The commission shall select one of its members as chairperson and another member as vice chairperson, for such terms and with duties and powers necessary for the performance of the functions of such offices as the commission determines.⁵ The commission must:⁶

- Direct the performance by the Director of the Department of Land Conservation and Development and the director's staff of their statutory functions;
- Adopt rules that it considers necessary to carry out Oregon's land use conservation and development policies;
- Cooperate with the appropriate agencies of the United States, this state and its political subdivisions, any other state, any interstate agency, any person or groups of persons with respect to land conservation and development;
- Appoint advisory committees as necessary to provide technical and other assistance;
- Adopt, amend and revise goals consistent with regional, county and city concerns;
- Prepare, collect, provide or cause to be prepared, collected or provided land use inventories;
- Prepare statewide planning guidelines;
- Review comprehensive plans for compliance with goals;
- Coordinate planning efforts of state agencies to assure compliance with goals and compatibility with city and county comprehensive plans;
- Insure widespread citizen involvement and input in all phases of the process;
- Review and recommend to the Legislative Assembly the designation of areas of critical state concern;
- Report periodically to the Legislative Assembly and to the committee; and,
- Review the land use planning responsibilities and authorities given to the state, regions, counties and cities, review the resources available to each level of government and make recommendations to the Legislative Assembly to improve the administration of the statewide land use program.

The commission may:⁷

- Apply for and receive moneys from the federal government and from this state or any of its agencies or departments;
- Contract with any public agency for the performance of services or the exchange of employees or services as necessary;

- Contract for the services of and consultation with professional persons or organizations, not otherwise available through federal, state, and local governmental agencies as necessary;
- Perform other functions required to carry out its statutory mission;
- Assist in development and preparation of model land use regulations to guide state agencies, cities, counties and special districts in implementing goals; and,
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, review comprehensive plan and land use regulations related to the identification and designation of high-value farmland.
