SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 1556 Relating to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission

SB 1556 authorizes the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to market and sell data or access related to data concerning commercial sales and commercial industries. The measure also allows OLCC to negotiate certain distilled liquor prices directly with commercial airlines and tribes.

The recommended amendment directs revenue realized from such sale of information to either the liquor fund for distribution, or to the Marijuana Control and Regulation Fund.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends SB 1556 be amended by the –A2 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
