\$1,165,013 Includes: demolition and construction within the Vietnam Memorial project area, not including pathways or the new central oval north of Memorial site

Part B: Memorial Art Elements

\$735,683 Includes fabrication and installation of: Column Wall Monument, 4 Brothers benches, MIA/POW station, Nurses Station sculpture, A Soldier's Return sculpture, Persian Gulf War Memorial, Gold Star Families Memorial Monument, Purple Heart Plaque

Part C: Additional Cost Factors

\$306,052 Includes: 3D Visual Simulation, Architectural and Engineering, Committee Review, Building Permits, Interpretive Design and App Development

Part D: Administrative Costs

\$498,564 Includes: Fundraising, marketing, administrative costs, contingencies, etc.
