> These are needed strategies, because many families have to make tough decisions about whether to keep the heat on in the winter or pay for medicine or food. Lack of home heat, financial stress, and malnourishment and lack of access to medications have a huge spread of harmful mental and physical health impacts including cases of asthma, respiratory problems, heart disease, arthritis, rheumatism, and more. Children and seniors are most susceptible to these health impacts. Energy affordability is paramount especially for those with chronic health needs such as an asthmatic who relies on electric-powered nebulizers, or a diabetic who needs to refrigerate insulin.

> Programs like weatherization and energy assistance are oversubscribed and don't reach everyone in need, but HB 4067 would open a new toolbox that could help more families afford energy bills and be safe and comfortable in their homes.
