**Measure Description:**

Modifies protective proceedings to permit vulnerable youth guardianships for adults between 18 and 21 years of age who are not citizens or lawful permanent residents of United States and who are unable to be reunified with parent due to abuse, neglect or abandonment that occurred before adult attained 18 years of age.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Long Term Care Ombudsman (LTCO), Department of Human Services (DHS)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
