## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs Oregon Housing and Community Services (OHCS) to study housing-related laws and deliver findings to the interim Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2020. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- HB 2003 (2019)
- Cities completing their own housing needs analyses versus Metro completing the analyses for the cities
- Requirements for cities outside of Metro when applying to expand their urban growth boundaries

## **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Oregon Housing and Community Services (OHCS) is the state's housing finance agency and provides financial and programmatic support to create and preserve quality, affordable housing opportunities for low- to moderate-income Oregonians. House Bill 4015 directs the study of housing-related laws by OHCS.
