## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Prohibits police officer from conducting or participating in activities intended to determine whether person has paid certain user charges, fees or tolls imposed by mass transit district. **Specifies exceptions.** 

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to mass transit districts.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A police officer may not conduct or participate in activities intended to

determine whether a person has paid user charges, fees or tolls imposed by a mass transit
 district under ORS 267.320.

7 (2) Nothing in this section prohibits a police officer from:

8 (a) Being present on the property or in a motor vehicle of a mass transit district;

9 (b) Enforcing laws that are not related to payment of user charges, fees or tolls imposed

10 by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320; or

(c) Intervening in any situation in which the safety of a police officer or the public is at
 risk.

(3) As used in this section, "police officer" has the meaning given that term in ORS
181A.355.
