

Requested by Senator FINDLEY

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1530**

1 On page 10 of the printed bill, after line 30, insert:

2 **“SECTION 12a. Retirement of allowances for certain propane**  
3 **importers and suppliers. (1) As used in this section:**

4 (a) ‘Propane service’ means the final delivery of propane into a  
5 propane tank located on the premises of a residential or commercial  
6 propane customer.

7 “(b) ‘Propane service’ does not mean the delivery, sale or filling of  
8 a propane cylinder.

9 “(2) Subject to subsection (3) of this section, the Office of  
10 Greenhouse Gas Regulation shall annually retire from the annual al-  
11 lowance budget, on behalf of a covered entity described in section 5  
12 (2)(d) of this 2020 Act, a number of allowances equal to the total of:

13 “(a) The regulated emissions of the covered entity attributable to  
14 the provision of propane service to the low-income residential cus-  
15 tomers of the covered entity, as determined by the office; and

16 “(b) Sixty percent of the regulated emissions of the covered entity  
17 attributable to the provision of propane service to customers of the  
18 covered entity that are not low-income residential customers.

19 “(3) In 2023 and in each following year before 2051, the number of  
20 allowances retired under subsection (2)(b) of this section shall decline  
21 annually by a constant amount proportionate to the decline in the

1 **number of allowances available in annual allowance budgets pursuant**  
2 **to section 5 (1)(b) of this 2020 Act.**

3 **“(4) Allowances directly retired by the office on behalf of a covered**  
4 **entity under this section shall count toward fulfilling the covered**  
5 **entity’s compliance obligation for the compliance period during which**  
6 **the allowances are directly retired. A covered entity may not include**  
7 **in the rate or bill charged for propane service for which allowances**  
8 **are directly retired under this section any costs associated with com-**  
9 **pliance by the covered entity with the Oregon Greenhouse Gas Initi-**  
10 **ative.”.**

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
