PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4016

- In line 2 of the printed bill, delete "and declaring an emergency" and in-
- 2 sert "creating new provisions; amending ORS 443.001; and prescribing an ef-
- 3 fective date".
- Delete lines 4 through 10 and insert:
- ⁵ "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
- 6 "(a) 'Emergency care' has the meaning given that term in ORS 7 682.025.
- 8 "(b) 'Long term care facility' has the meaning given that term in 9 ORS 442.015.
- "(c) 'Residential care facility' has the meaning given that term in ORS 443.400.
- "(2)(a) The Emergency Medical Services Innovation Program is established in the Department of Human Services. The purpose of the program is to select, provide funding to and monitor local public sector pilot projects that:
- "(A) Provide innovative strategies for addressing the emergency medical services needs of this state's increasing number of aging residents who receive care and services in residential care facilities and long term care facilities;
- 20 "(B) Encourage the efficient and appropriate use of emergency 21 medical services;

- "(C) Reduce the costs of emergency medical services while promoting quality emergency medical services; and
- "(D) Encourage unique community-based responses to challenges faced by local communities in meeting their residents' needs for emergency medical services.
- "(b) The department shall provide funding to a pilot project described in this subsection from moneys deposited in the Quality Care Fund established under ORS 443.001.
- "(3) The Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council is established consisting of the following seven members appointed by the Governor:
- "(a) One member representing long term care facilities;
 - "(b) One member representing residential care facilities;
- 14 "(c) One member who is a nurse or clinician in a long term care 15 facility or a residential care facility;
- "(d) One member representing an urban or suburban fire department or a city fire department that provides emergency medical services;
- "(e) One member representing a rural fire protection district or-20 ganized under ORS chapter 478;
 - "(f) One member who enters into agreements with a public sector entity to provide emergency medical services; and
- 23 "(g) One member who is a physician licensed under ORS chapter 24 677 or other health care practitioner with expertise in emergency care.
- 25 "(4) The council shall advise and make recommendations to the 26 Department of Human Services on:
- "(a) Minimum standards and data reporting requirements for pilot projects funded through the program;
- 29 "(b) The application process and timelines for the consideration of 30 applications for funding of pilot projects;

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- "(c) The criteria for the selection of pilot projects to participate in the program; and
- 3 "(d) Other factors identified by the council as likely to facilitate 4 successful pilot projects.
- 5 "(5) A majority of the members of the council constitutes a quorum 6 for the transaction of business.
- "(6) Official action by the council requires the approval of a massimity of the members of the council.
- 9 "(7) The council shall elect one of its members to serve as chair-10 person.
- 11 "(8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make 12 an appointment to become immediately effective.
 - "(9) The council shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the council.
- 15 "(10) The council may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the council.
 - "(11) The department shall submit a report, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, on the pilot projects selected for the program, the success achieved by each pilot project in meeting the goals of the program described in subsection (2) of this section and any recommendations for legislative changes necessary to improve the emergency services provided throughout this state.

 - "(13) Members of the council are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the council.
- "(14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the council in the performance of the duties of the council and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the council consider necessary to perform their duties.

- 8 "(d) 'Long term care facility' has the meaning given that term in ORS 442.015.
- "(e) 'Residential care facility' has the meaning given that term in ORS 443.400.
- "(2) The governing body of a local government may not enact or enforce any charter provision, ordinance, resolution or other regulation that:
 - "(a) Regulates a long term care facility or residential care facility that is regulated by the Department of Human Services under state or federal law, or pursuant to rules adopted by the department; or
- "(b) Imposes fees or other requirements that apply exclusively to long term care facilities or residential care facilities and are not generally applicable to business entities operating within the jurisdiction of the local government.
