**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1574**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “352.823,” insert “366.505,”.

2 In line 4, delete “and section 12,”.

3 In line 5, delete “chapter 751, Oregon Laws 2009,”.

4 On page 2, line 6, after the semicolon insert “and”.

5 On page 30, delete lines 25 through 30 and insert:

6 “(4)(a) Of the moneys available in the account for distribution each  
7 biennium, 12 percent shall be transferred to the State Highway Fund for al-  
8 location as follows:

9 “(A) 50 percent to the Department of Transportation;

10 “(B) 30 percent to counties for distribution as provided in ORS 366.764;  
11 and

12 “(C) 20 percent to cities in the proportion that each city’s population  
13 bears to the total population of all the cities.

14 “(b) Of the moneys available in the account after the allocation under  
15 paragraph (a) of this subsection:

16 “(A) 20 percent shall be used by the department for transportation  
17 projects selected by the Oregon Transportation Commission pursuant to  
18 section 35 of this 2020 Act; and

19 “(B) 80 percent shall be distributed by the commission to local govern-  
20 ments under section 36 of this 2020 Act for implementation, including plan-  
21 ning for implementation, of metropolitan climate plans.”.

1 In line 32, delete “(4)(b)” and insert “(4)(b)(B)”.

2 On page 31, line 6, delete “(4)(a)” and insert “(4)(b)(A)”.

3 In line 13, delete “(4)(a)” and insert “(4)(b)(A)”.

4 In line 22, delete “(4)(b)” and insert “(4)(b)(B)”.

5 In line 28, delete “(4)(b)” and insert “(4)(b)(B)”.

6 On page 32, after line 31, insert:

7 **“SECTION 37a.** ORS 366.505 is amended to read:

8 “366.505. (1) The State Highway Fund shall consist of:

9 “(a) All moneys and revenues derived under and by virtue of the sale of

10 bonds, the sale of which is authorized by law and the proceeds thereof to be

11 dedicated to highway purposes.

12 “(b) All moneys and revenues accruing from the licensing of motor vehi-

13 cles, operators and chauffeurs.

14 “(c) Moneys and revenues derived from any tax levied upon gasoline,

15 distillate, liberty fuel or other volatile and inflammable liquid fuels, except

16 moneys and revenues described in ORS 184.642 (2)(a) that become part of the

17 Department of Transportation Operating Fund.

18 “(d) Moneys and revenues derived from the road usage charges imposed

19 under ORS 319.885.

20 “(e) Moneys and revenues derived from the use tax imposed under ORS

21 320.410.

22 **“(f) Moneys transferred from the Transportation Decarbonization**

23 **Investments Account established under section 34 of this 2020 Act.**

24 “[~~f~~] (g) Moneys and revenues derived from or made available by the

25 federal government for road construction, maintenance or betterment pur-

26 poses.

27 “[~~g~~] (h) All moneys and revenues received from all other sources which

28 by law are allocated or dedicated for highway purposes.

29 “(2) The State Highway Fund shall be deemed and held as a trust fund,

30 separate and distinct from the General Fund, and may be used only for the

1 purposes authorized by law and is continually appropriated for such pur-  
2 poses.

3 “(3) Moneys in the State Highway Fund may be invested as provided in  
4 ORS 293.701 to 293.857. All interest earnings on any of the funds designated  
5 in subsection (1) of this section shall be placed to the credit of the highway  
6 fund.”.
