PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4010

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page 2 2 and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Legislative Revenue Officer shall study the
 operation, benefits, impact and effectiveness of the federal opportunity
 zone program in Oregon.

"(2) In conducting the study required by subsection (1) of this section, the officer shall consult with members of the Legislative Assembly and with individuals representing the following:

9 "(a) Construction trade organizations;

10 **"(b) Labor organizations;**

"(c) Private equity concerns, including those working with qualified
 opportunity funds;

13 "(d) Tax policy advocates;

"(e) Tax practitioners, including those working with qualified op portunity funds;

"(f) Economic and community development organizations, including
 those located in areas where opportunity zones are located; and

"(g) Local governments, including those of rural and urban juris dictions where opportunity zones are located.

"(3) The officer shall report findings to interim committees of the
 Legislative Assembly related to revenue and to economic development

in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than November 1, 2020.
The report may include any recommendations, if appropriate, by the
officer for legislation related to the opportunity zone program in
Oregon.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2020 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
date on which the 2020 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative
Assembly adjourns sine die.".
