PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4097

1 Delete lines 4 through 14 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert:

2 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1)(a) A police officer may not participate in a fare 3 enforcement mission unless a fare inspector or other mass transit 4 district employee, other than a mass transit vehicle operator, is pres-5 ent and directing the fare enforcement mission.

6 "(b) A police officer participating in a fare enforcement mission 7 may not check for an arrest warrant for a person who has only com-8 mitted, or who is only suspected of committing, the offense of:

9 "(A) Failing to pay a user charge, fee or toll imposed by a mass
10 transit district under ORS 267.320; or

"(B) Failing to provide proof of payment of a user charge, fee or toll
 imposed by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320.

13 "(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a police officer from:

"(a) Being present on the property of, or in a motor or light rail
 vehicle of, a mass transit district;

"(b) Enforcing laws that are not related to payment of user charges,
 fees or tolls imposed by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320; or

"(c) Intervening in any situation in which the safety of any person
is at risk.

20 "(3) A mass transit district is immune from liability for any claim 21 for injury to or death of any person, or injury to property, resulting from a police officer's nonparticipation in a fare enforcement mission as required by this section. The state shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless a mass transit district with respect to any claim for injury to or death of any person, or injury to property, resulting from a police officer's nonparticipation in a fare enforcement mission as required by this section.

7 "(4) As used in this section:

"(a) 'Fare enforcement mission' means activities intended to determine whether a person has paid user charges, fees or tolls imposed
by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320.

"(b) 'Police officer' has the meaning given that term in ORS
181A.355.".
