PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4097

1 Delete lines 4 through 14 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert:

2 "SECTION 1. (1)(a) A request for proof of payment, to determine 3 whether a person has paid user charges, fees or tolls imposed by a 4 mass transit district under ORS 267.320, may be made only by an 5 enforcement officer as defined in ORS 153.005, or another authorized 6 district employee, who is not a peace officer.

"(b) A peace officer may not check for an arrest warrant for a
person who has committed, or who is suspected of committing, only
the offense of:

"(A) Failing to pay a user charge, fee or toll imposed by a mass
 transit district under ORS 267.320; or

"(B) Failing to provide proof of payment of a user charge, fee or toll
 imposed by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320.

14 "(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a peace officer from:

"(a) Assisting in identifying a person, or conducting any authorized
 activities reasonably related to the issuance of a citation, once an
 enforcement officer or another authorized district employee has rea sonable suspicion that the person has violated an ordinance of a mass
 transit district related to payment of user charges, fees or tolls;

"(b) Being present on the property of, or in a motor or light rail
 vehicle of, a mass transit district;

"(c) Enforcing laws that are not related to payment of user charges,
fees or tolls imposed by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320; or
"(d) Intervening in any situation in which the safety of any person
is at risk.

"(3) A mass transit district is immune from liability for any claim
for injury to or death of any person, or injury to property, resulting
from a peace officer's nonparticipation in a fare enforcement mission
as required by this section.

9 "(4) As used in this section:

"(a) 'Fare enforcement mission' means activities intended to determine whether a person has paid user charges, fees or tolls imposed
by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320.

"(b) 'Peace officer' has the meaning given that term in ORS
13.005.".
