

Requested by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4167**

1 On page 91 of the printed bill, delete lines 28 through 37 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 108. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other ap-**
3 **propriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development**
4 **Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General**
5 **Fund, the amount of \$10,000,000 for deposit in the Traded Sector**
6 **Greenhouse Gas Reduction Revolving Loan Fund established under**
7 **section 51 of this 2020 Act.**

8 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the**
9 **amount of \$500,000 is established for the biennium ending June 30, 2021,**
10 **as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon Business**
11 **Development Department from the Traded Sector Greenhouse Gas**
12 **Reduction Revolving Loan Fund established under section 51 of this**
13 **2020 Act.**

14 **“(3) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there**
15 **is appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality, for the**
16 **biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount**
17 **of \$8,877,792 for expenses related to the implementation of the Oregon**
18 **Greenhouse Gas Initiative.**

19 **“(4) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-**
20 **tation on expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter 663, Oregon**
21 **Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the maximum**

1 limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,
2 including Miscellaneous Receipts, the proceeds of bonds for the Or-
3 phan Site Account and federal funds from congestion mitigation and
4 air quality grants, drinking water protection, beach bacteria monitor-
5 ing, laboratory accreditation and woodstove grants and for smoke
6 monitoring laboratory services, but excluding lottery funds and federal
7 funds not described in section 2, chapter 663, Oregon Laws 2019, col-
8 lected or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for
9 air quality, is increased by \$145,722 for development and implementa-
10 tion of new regulations on the monitoring and control of methane
11 emissions from certain solid waste landfills.

12 “(5) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there
13 is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for
14 the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
15 amount of \$100,000 for expenses related to the reporting requirements
16 established under section 95e of this 2020 Act.

17 “(6) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-
18 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (6), chapter 692, Oregon
19 Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the maximum
20 limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,
21 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and fed-
22 eral funds, collected or received by the Department of Justice, for the
23 General Counsel Division, is increased by \$455,597 to carry out the
24 provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020 Act.

25 “(7) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-
26 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (7), chapter 518, Oregon
27 Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the maximum
28 limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,
29 including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds received from
30 charges, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described

1 in section 2, chapter 518, Oregon Laws 2019, collected or received by
2 the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for Enterprise
3 Goods and Services, is increased by \$307,170 to study options for
4 awarding state procurement contracts that account for the greenhouse
5 gas emissions implications of transporting goods and services to
6 Oregon and develop a model program for local governments and spe-
7 cial government bodies to follow in planning to procure zero-emission
8 vehicles.

9 “(8) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
10 appropriation made to the State Department of Agriculture by section
11 1 (3), chapter 452, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30,
12 2021, for natural resources, is increased by \$111,536 to provide consul-
13 tation and research about agricultural lands and industries and the
14 viability of different offset protocols.

15 “(9) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there
16 is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department,
17 for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
18 amount of \$158,091 to develop a program proposal to assist households
19 that use fuels other than natural gas for residential home heating and
20 report on the proposal.

21 “(10) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
22 appropriation made to the Legislative Revenue Officer by section 15,
23 chapter 693, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021,
24 is increased by \$150,000 for expenses related to the reporting require-
25 ments established under section 93 of this 2020 Act.

26 “(11) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
27 appropriation made to the Department of Land Conservation and De-
28 velopment by section 1 (1), chapter 669, Oregon Laws 2019, for the
29 biennium ending June 30, 2021, for the planning program, is increased
30 by \$327,162 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020

1 Act.

2 “(12) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there
3 is appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium
4 ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$119,215
5 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020 Act.

6 “(13) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the
7 limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (11), chapter 614,
8 Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the max-
9 imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-
10 nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds received as
11 reimbursement from the United States Department of Transportation,
12 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section
13 2, chapter 614, Oregon Laws 2019, collected or received by the Depart-
14 ment of Transportation, for transportation program development, is
15 increased by \$127,517 for work related to the management of the
16 Transportation Decarbonization Investments Account program.

17 “(14) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the
18 limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (1), chapter 185,
19 Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the max-
20 imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-
21 nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds
22 and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Utility Commis-
23 sion, for the utility program, is increased by \$1,349,780 to carry out the
24 provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020 Act.

25 “(15) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there
26 is appropriated to the Public Utility Commission, for the biennium
27 ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$29,566
28 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020 Act.”.

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
