- 1. A jurisdiction's path to success must be clear, objective, and within its control.
- 2. Recognize jurisdictions' success if they solve problems in unanticipated ways.
- 3. Apply separate tests for separate goals.
- 4. Many goals will fail without public investment.
- 5. The state needs policy change, too.
- 6. We shouldn't mistake systemic change for emergency action.



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
