HB 2358

**CARRIED OVER FROM 4/7/2021 AGENDA:** Prohibits employers from permitting or requiring agricultural workers to work in excess of 40 hours in one workweek unless workers are compensated for overtime hours worked. *Please note: HB 2358 is being scheduled solely for the purpose of moving it to the House Committee on Rules.*

HB 2906

**CARRIED OVER FROM 4/7/2021 AGENDA:** Directs Public Employees Retirement Board to study methods for allowing members of Public Employees Retirement System to certify that member will earn less than \$30,000 in calendar year so that board does not credit employee contributions to employee pension stability account. *Please note: HB 2906 is being scheduled solely for the purpose of moving it to the House Committee on Rules.*

HB 3212

**CARRIED OVER FROM 4/7/2021 AGENDA:** Lowers number of actions to foreclose trust deed by advertisement and sale or by suit that beneficiary may commence during preceding calendar year and still claim exemption from requirement to participate in resolution conference with borrower that has failed to pay amount due on obligation secured by residential real property. *Please note: HB 3212 is being scheduled solely for the purpose of moving it to the House Committee on Rules.*

HB 3171

**CARRIED OVER FROM 4/7/2021 AGENDA:** Includes insurance in definition of real estate, goods and services that are subject to penalties for unlawful trade practices.

HB 3272

**CARRIED OVER FROM 4/7/2021 AGENDA:** Requires insurer that provides coverage for full replacement costs of damaged or destroyed property to allow insured not less than 24 months of

additional living expenses and not less than 24 months within which to repair, rebuild or replace damaged or lost property or, if damage or loss to the property results from emergency or major disaster, not less than 36 months of additional living expenses and time within which to repair, rebuild or replace damaged or lost property.

HB 3188

***CARRIED OVER FROM 4/7/2021 AGENDA:*** Changes definitions of "employer" and "worker" for purposes of workers' compensation law.
