HB 2697

(1:40 pm) Directs Department of Education to conduct study on meeting students' behavioral health needs and to report results of study to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education by September 1, 2021.

HB 2631

(2:00 pm) Prescribes notification requirements for school district upon receipt of report of act of harassment, intimidation, bullying or cyberbullying.

Unless otherwise noted on the agenda, testimony is only accepted by committees for bills or topics scheduled for a public hearing. See the Oregon Legislature's website for information on contacting individual legislators directly on bills or topics not scheduled for a public hearing.
