Work Session

HB 2282

(8:05am) Requires Department of Land Conservation and Development to approve City of Bend's expansion of urban growth boundary, and allows department to approve other land use regulations for city on specified lands, if owner of land possesses development opportunity transferred from Metolius resort site owner and city meets other conditions.

HB 2334

(8:30am) Modifies provisions relating to statement of cost of compliance effect on small businesses required as part of agency rulemaking.

HB 3040

(8:45am) Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to study system development charges and report findings to interim committees related to local government.

HB 3177 **

(9:00am) Limits types of restrictions that Governor may impose on certain businesses during state of emergency related to COVID-19 pandemic.

- HB 2701 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Housing then to Ways and Means
(9:15am) CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/25/2021 MEETING: Establishes Rural System Development Charges Program within Housing and Community Services Department to pay system development charges for rural affordable multifamily housing.
- HB 2820 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
(9:25am) CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/25/2021 MEETING: Establishes Prosperity 1,000 Pilot Program to provide career coaching, occupational training and job placement services for at least 1,000 low-income job seekers residing in areas of concentrated poverty.
- HB 3256
(9:35am) CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/25/2021 MEETING: Directs Public Utility Commission to study laws related to telecommunications and provide results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.

Note change: HB 3177 time has been changed. Work Sessions for HB 2701, HB 2820, and HB 3256 added.
