(3:50 pm) Authorizes Oregon Liquor Control Commission to negotiate price for certain distilled liquor purchased by Indian tribe or commercial airline.

Written Testimony

Written testimony should be submitted via the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS) testimony portal. Testimony must be received within 24 hours after the start time of the meeting in which the public hearing is held. Testimony is uploaded to OLIS as part of the legislative record and made publicly available at <https://olis.leg.state.or.us/liz/2021R1/Committees/HGG/Overview>.

Oral Testimony (Live Remotely)
